

Virginia school turnaround

Since 2010, Cambridge Education has been working as LTP in the state of Virginia. During this time, we have served 13 schools across 9 districts, delivering a range of services personalized to meet the specific needs of each school.

By the end of SIG Cohort I:

- 2 of the 6 schools we served were fully accredited.
- The remaining 4 schools all moved out of priority status.

For SIG Cohort III and IV, we are currently serving 8 schools in 5 school divisions. One of these schools, Bryan Elementary, was recently awarded conditional accreditation based on strong growth performance:

- Bryan is fully accredited in 3 of the 4 core subjects: math, science, and history, and has made substantial progress in English.
- The number of students with unexcused absences has been reduced by 50% over the last two years, the third highest reduction in the school district, and the largest reduction by an elementary school in the state.
